- The Passport Kitchen virtual/self-paced program is open to youth ages 9-18 years old.
- The cost to participate is \$20. Fees made payable to Barren County 4-H.
- Deadline to submit registration and payment— Friday, October 14th. This will allow enough time to get registrations and payment sent to the state office by their deadline of Oct. 17th.
- Countries that you will explore through food: Mexico, Brazil, Germany, Laos and South Africa.
- What will you receive? You will receive one kit per week beginning Oct. 28th and ending on Dec. 2nd.
 Each kit will include: a recipe card for a local dish, a link to a cook-along YouTube video, an informational brochure about the country, a passport stamp, a boarding pass, one ingredient from the dish, a shopping list. (Members will be expected to gather most ingredients, ingredients that may not be easy to find will be provided in the kit.)
- Participating members will also be expected to complete an evaluation at the end of the program and share pictures. (This may be in the form of a meeting held at the Extension Office, where participants can share their favorite recipe from the project, if we have enough participation.)
- To register, contact the Barren County Extension Office at 270-651-3818.

As part of the 4-H Global Table program, young people from Kentucky will be exchanging recipes with young people in Taiwan, Papua New Guinea, The Netherlands, or Argentina. Additionally, young people will prepare recipes provided to them by their counterparts from the young person they are paired with and share their experience at the ending celebration via zoom.

This is a virtual program offered to youth ages 11-18. The cost is \$30 per youth. Registration will open in November and close in January 2023.

The program will run from January through April. Participants will be expected to attend a virtual orientation, select and upload a recipe to share, prepare a recipe from another country, engage in prompts at least every other week, upload photos and a reflection, attend Zoom celebration. Ingredients that may not be easily found, may be provided by the state office. Registration is very limited. Sorghum Gingerbread Pear Muffins

 1 cup whole-wheat flour
 ½ teaspoon baking powder
 ½ teaspoon baking soda
 ½ teaspoon ground cinnamon ½ teaspoonground ginger¼ teaspoon salt1 egg½ cup buttermilk

½ cup sorghum syrup
½ cup unsweetened applesauce
1 pear, peeled, cored, and diced

Preheat oven to 375 degrees F. **Grease** 12 muffin cups or line with paper liners. In a mixing bowl, **combine** the flour, baking powder, baking soda, cinnamon, ginger, and salt. In a separate bowl, **mix** together the egg, buttermilk, sorghum syrup and applesauce until smooth. **Add** the egg mixture to the flour mixture and **combine** until the batter is just moistened. Gently **fold** in the diced pears. **Fill** the muffin cups with the mixture. They will be full. **Bake** in the preheated oven until a toothpick inserted in the center of a muffin comes out clean, about 20 minutes.

Yield: 12 muffins. Serving size, one muffin.
