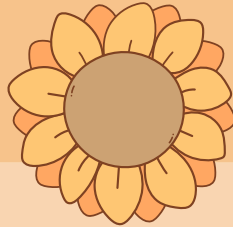

- October 17 Area Annual Day in Hart County, nametags provided (pre-registration was required)



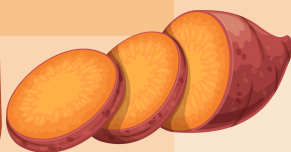
